Role & Responsibilities

Our team works in English. Therefore, it will be your task to interpret what is said by our legal case workers and the people seeking advice. You will also support the team by communicating with those who need assistance via phone or messenger.

Legal knowledge is not necessary as we will provide training as part of your on-boarding. You will also be supported in all of these tasks by the lawyer, the coordinators and caseworkers.

Qualification & Requirements

- Proficiency in Amharic and in English
- Interest in issues of human rights and forced migration
- Experience in teamwork
- Ability to work flexibly and to take appointments remotely generally between 10am–5pm EEST Tuesdays–Fridays, although additional interpretation work can take place outside of these hours.
- Ability to commit to a minimum of three months of collaboration and a minimum amount of working hours of 1,5 hours per week.

Preferred Skills

- Experience in interpreting counselling situations with refugees in matters of asylum law (e.g. interview preparation)
- Experience in the non-profit sector
